## DESCRIPTION

The Safety Manager is responsible for developing, updating, and maintaining safety, food safety, and environmental compliance programs. Maintains reports and verifies compliance. Supervises employees, contractors and visitors by spending a significant amount of time in the plant ensuring all programs and procedures are adequate and being followed. Sustains and improves current behavior based safety programs and policies. Leads and participates in all incident investigations. Conducts internal facility audits and facility self-assessments and develops and tracks corrective actions for audit findings.

## KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop, analyze and submit reports
- Calibrate and repair safety equipment
- Supervise the implementation of policies and procedures
- Develop and present training for new hires, contractors, and location colleagues as required
- Direct colleague interaction
- Purchase and maintain inventory of safety, food safety, and environmental supplies
- Develop and maintain proper document retention
- Maintain required paperwork such as OSHA 300 logs in compliance with federal law
- Lead and participate in on-site safety committee
